NOTICE INVITING COMMENTS ON TARIFF FILING

(Issued August 28, 2003)

On August 14, 2003, MCI WorldCom Communications (MCI) filed proposed revisions to its PSC No. 5 Telephone tariff that would amend the rate structure for its Maximum Security Rate Plan telephone service to inmates. MCI proposes to amend the rate structure based on time-of-day and distance to a single flat rate for local, intraLATA and interLATA long distance. The tariff has a proposed effective date of September 14, 2003.

Some comments have already been filed on the proposed changes. An individual has contacted the Commission, on behalf of several users, to request additional time to file comments. To ensure an orderly process, parties wishing to comment should submit an original and five copies of their comments to Jaclyn A. Brillling, Acting Secretary to the Commission, by 10:00 a.m. on September 10, 2003.
